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School Uniforms

SUMMER AND WINTER – GRADE R	
BOYS	GIRLS
Casual clothes with shoes/takkies, or Grade 1 Summer / Winter uniform (see below)	

SUMMER – GRADES 1 to 7

- 1 – School badges are available from the school at R30.00 each, and are required for all school shirt pockets, blazer pockets, beanies & jerseys/pullovers. The School badge can be ironed on & tacked onto the uniform around the edges.
- 2 – All clothing is to be clearly marked with your child's name tag sewn inside the clothing. Name tags printed on fabric strips are available from Ton Arts, 1A Evans St, Kimberley North, Kimberley, 8301, Telephone 053 831 1074.
- 3 – All uniform items are available from stores like Woolworths, Pep Stores, Ackermans, Jet Stores, etc. Blazers can also be found at Patel's Bargain Wholesalers, 43 Old Main, Tel 053 833 1003.
- 4 – Skirts are made by our skirt maker – Contact Jonathan on 0734736465, at Jono Clothing, Shop No 12, Corless Road, Kimberley (near Wookeys Fabrics), to have your child measured and the skirt made. Skirts cost R250 each and MUST be prepaid to the school before the skirts can be made.

Skirt Ordering Procedure

Please note the following procedure when ordering school skirts for your child:

1 – Pay your R250 per skirt at the school in cash, or pay into the school's bank account (Bank payments take 2 business days to appear on the bank statement).

NOTE: DO NOT PAY THE SKIRT MAKER FOR THE SKIRT.

2 – Confirm with Teacher Nicky or Principal Marietha at the school how many skirts you are ordering and have paid for.

3 – Call the skirt maker and arrange a time to go to him to have your child measured and the skirt made. Collect the skirt from him when done.

NOTE: DO NOT PAY THE SKIRT MAKER FOR THE SKIRT.

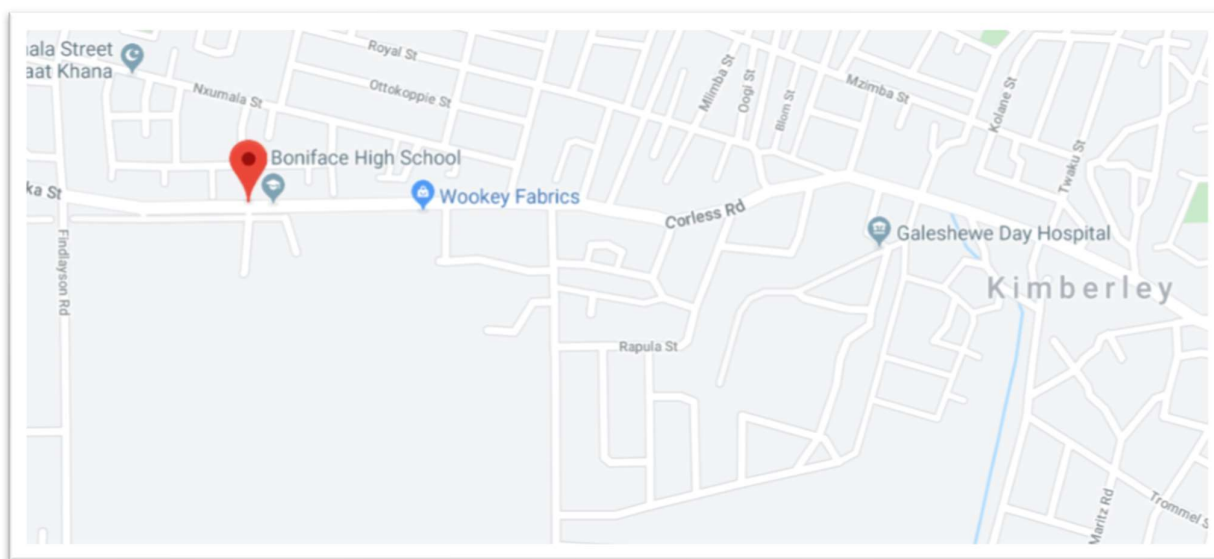

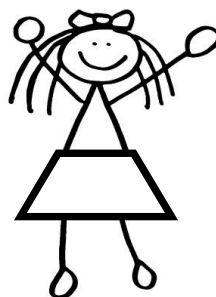


Your child will be measured individually for her skirts. Here is a guide on how to wear the skirt:

Top waistband level with belly-button



Skirt length just above the knee



The skirts are not designed to be worn as hipster-skirts, but rather waist-skirts. ie: the waistband of the skirt fits a little higher, level with the belly-button. The length of the skirt should be just above the knee.
